The Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) has partnered with St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center (SJHMC) to be involved in the CAPP Program. The program provides child passenger safety classes in both English and Spanish, and is taught by a Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician to drivers who have been issued a citation for ARS §28-907.A (child restraint law). Additionally, the child passenger safety classes are open to the general public.
