The Governor's Office of Highway Safety would like to extend an invitation to your agency for an upcoming 80 hour Accident Reconstruction Course provided by the Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM). The purpose of this course is to provide law enforcement officers the most current information in the following subject areas:

- **Speed Estimates from kinetic energy, skid marks, scuff marks, and airborne situations**
- **Vehicle dynamics and motion**
- **Time, distance and motion equations**
- **Conservation of momentum equations**
- **Center of mass calculation**
- **Vehicle lamp examination**
- **Tire damage evaluation**
- **Vector sum analysis**

The course is limited to twenty (25) students and will be held from Monday, September 12, through Friday, September 23, 2011, from 0800-1700 hours at Tucson Police Department classroom, 1310 West Miracle Mile, Tucson, Arizona. **The course registration fee is funded by GOHS but all applicable related travel expenditures must be covered by the agency and/or attending student.**

An additional 80 hour course is scheduled in Phoenix from August 15 through August 26, 2011.
