



In the spring of 2011, 28 states throughout the country, school bus drivers recorded in a one-day snapshot how many times other motorists passed their school buses illegally while the buses were stopped displaying their flashing red lights and stop arms. Almost 112,000 bus drivers reported 37,756 total stop arm passing incidents, often involving several cars in each incident. Reports were not available from all states, but in a typical 180-day school year, the 76,685 vehicles that passed school buses illegally represent well over 13 million violations by private motorists.
