Grants will boost DUI enforcement efforts

Sierra Vista, AZ. 11/13/15. The Sierra Vista Police Department recently received two grants from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety that will enhance its DUI enforcement efforts.

A grant for \$25,000 will help cover the department's overtime costs for impaired driving details, Covert Underage Buyers (CUB) Details designed to keep businesses from selling alcohol to minors, Victim Impact Panel meetings, and other drinking and driving related missions. A second grant of \$11,000 will fund the purchase of six preliminary breath testing devices and two mobile vehicle video recording systems.

"Without assistance from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety we could not have the impact we do on reducing impaired driving in the Sierra Vista area. Our thanks to GOHS Director Alberto Gutier for recognizing the needs of the Sierra Vista Police Department in providing these funds," Sierra Vista Police Department Commander Daryl Copp says.

Last year the Department participated in 17 scheduled DUI enforcement events throughout Cochise County.
