**III. Grant Awards and Grant Allocations– Alberto Gutier, GOHS Staffing Agency  
Review, discussion, consideration and possible action on grant applications to the council.**

- Tempe Police Department – Proposal #00110, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$50,000.00 enforcement grant, Chairman Linda Gray seconded and all in favor.
- Phoenix Police Department – Proposal #00113, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$30,000.00 innovative grant, Bill Peters seconded and all in favor. The program was a great success, the new grant award will expand the program to include video and audio PSA's. The link to the PSA videos is available on the GOHS website and can be downloaded and duplicated to share with the local community for other cities to apply.

- Safford Police Department – Proposal #00114, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$10,560.69 enforcement grant, Chairman Linda Gray seconded and all in favor. The equipment purchased under the grant award will be installed in two separate vehicles.
- Phoenix Police Department – Proposal #00115, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$100,000.00 enforcement and \$20,000.00 innovative grant, Bradley Beauchamp seconded and all in favor. Lieutenant Scott Sowerwine, Sergeant Carl Clovis and Detective Joe Bianchi from the Phoenix Police Department were present for the Council and available to answer any questions in regards to the proposal. The grant award will enable the agency to participate in the “Know Your Limit” program. The program was established by the Scottsdale Police Department a year ago and has been showcased nationally at the IACP conference.
